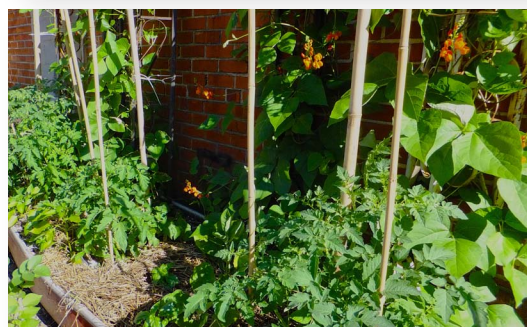
## February 21 | STARTING SEEDS INDOORS:
