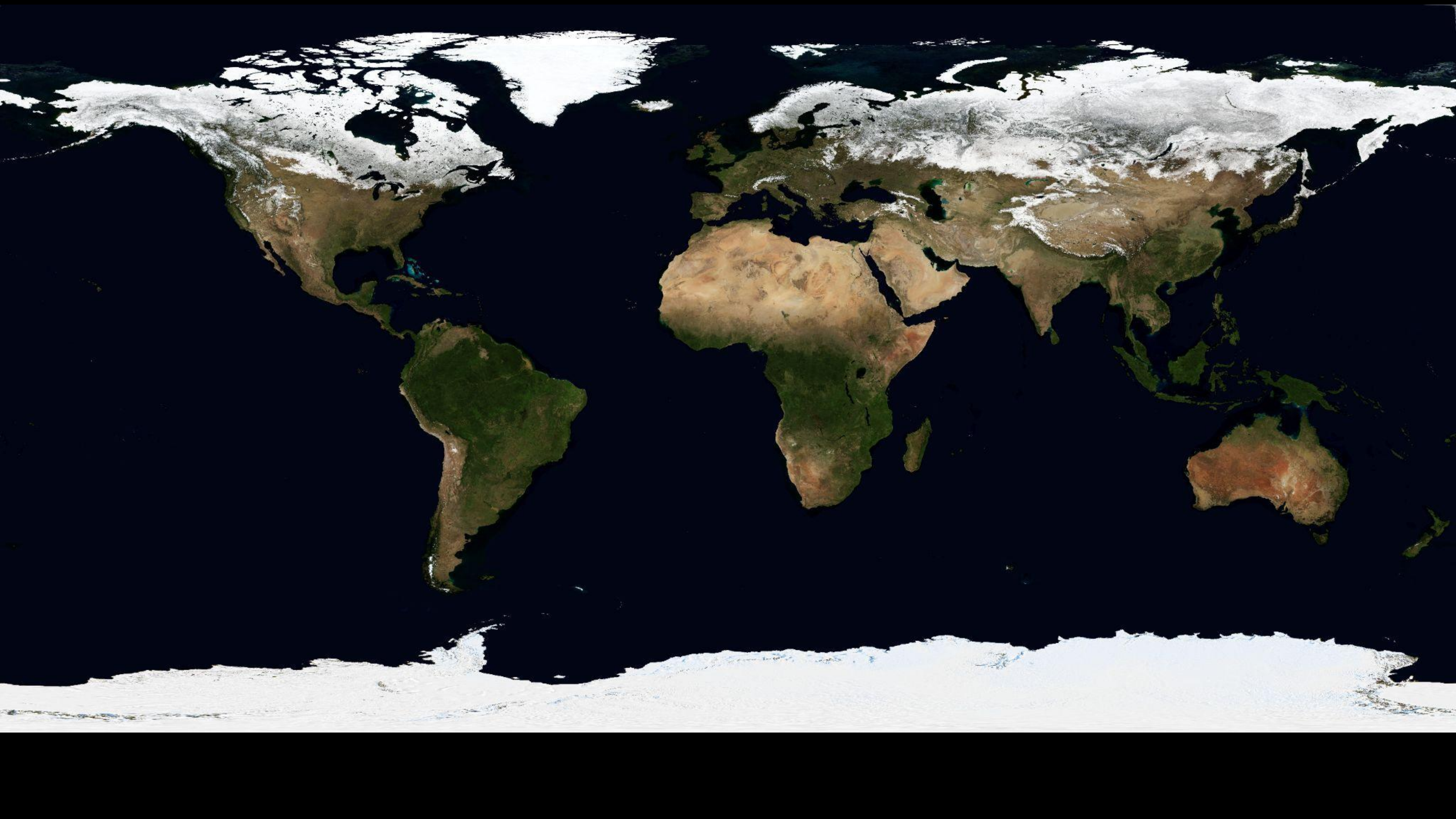


▲ Volcano Locations

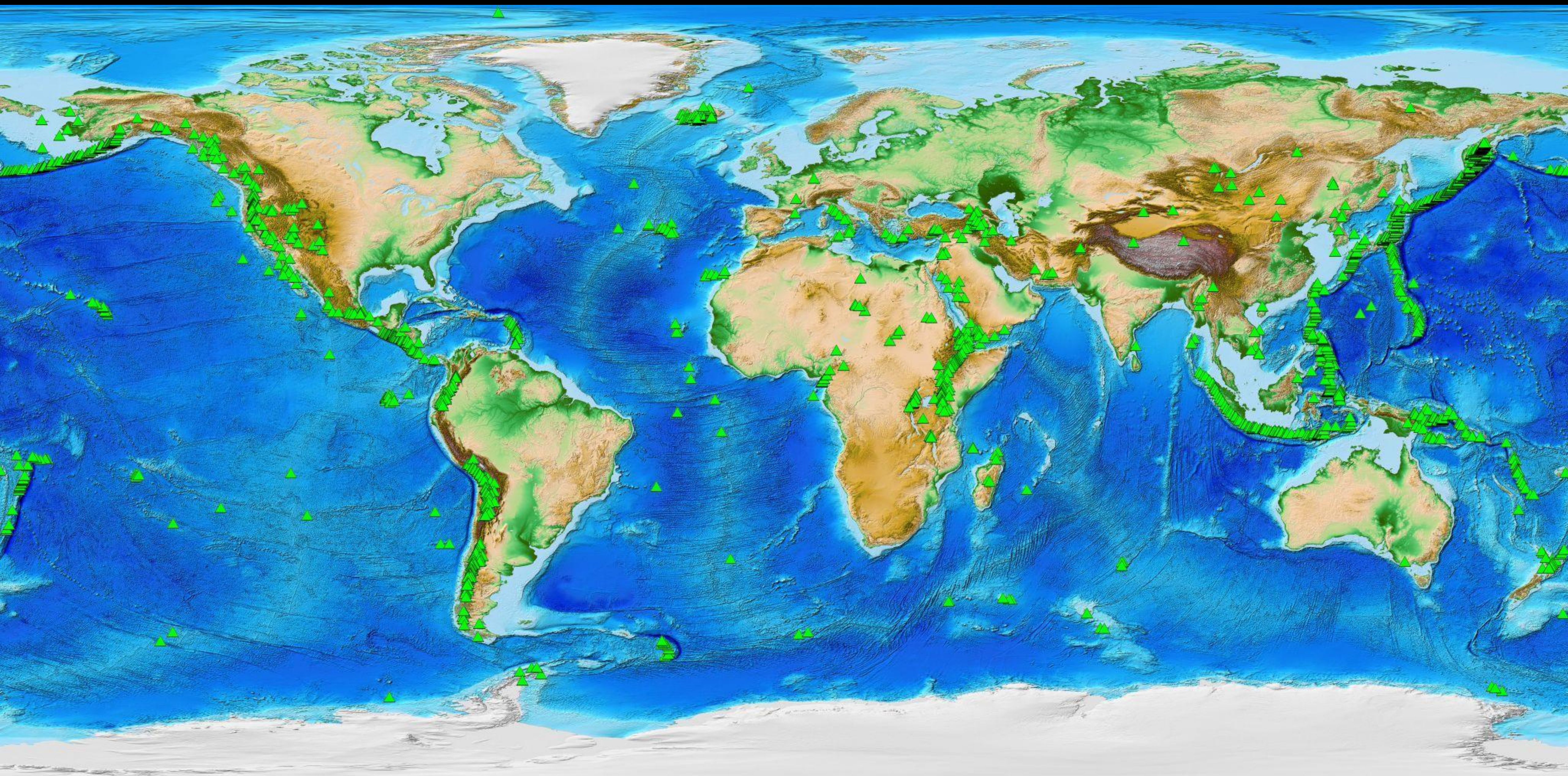
▲ Volcanic Eruption

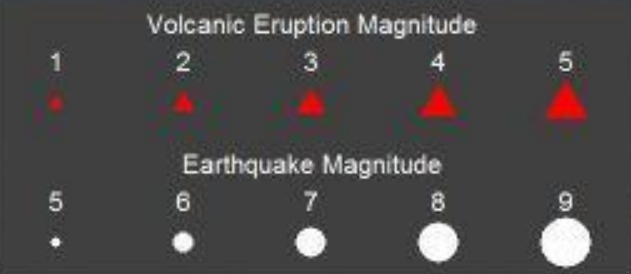
