If you’re the kind of person who always waits for others to speak, try to step up.

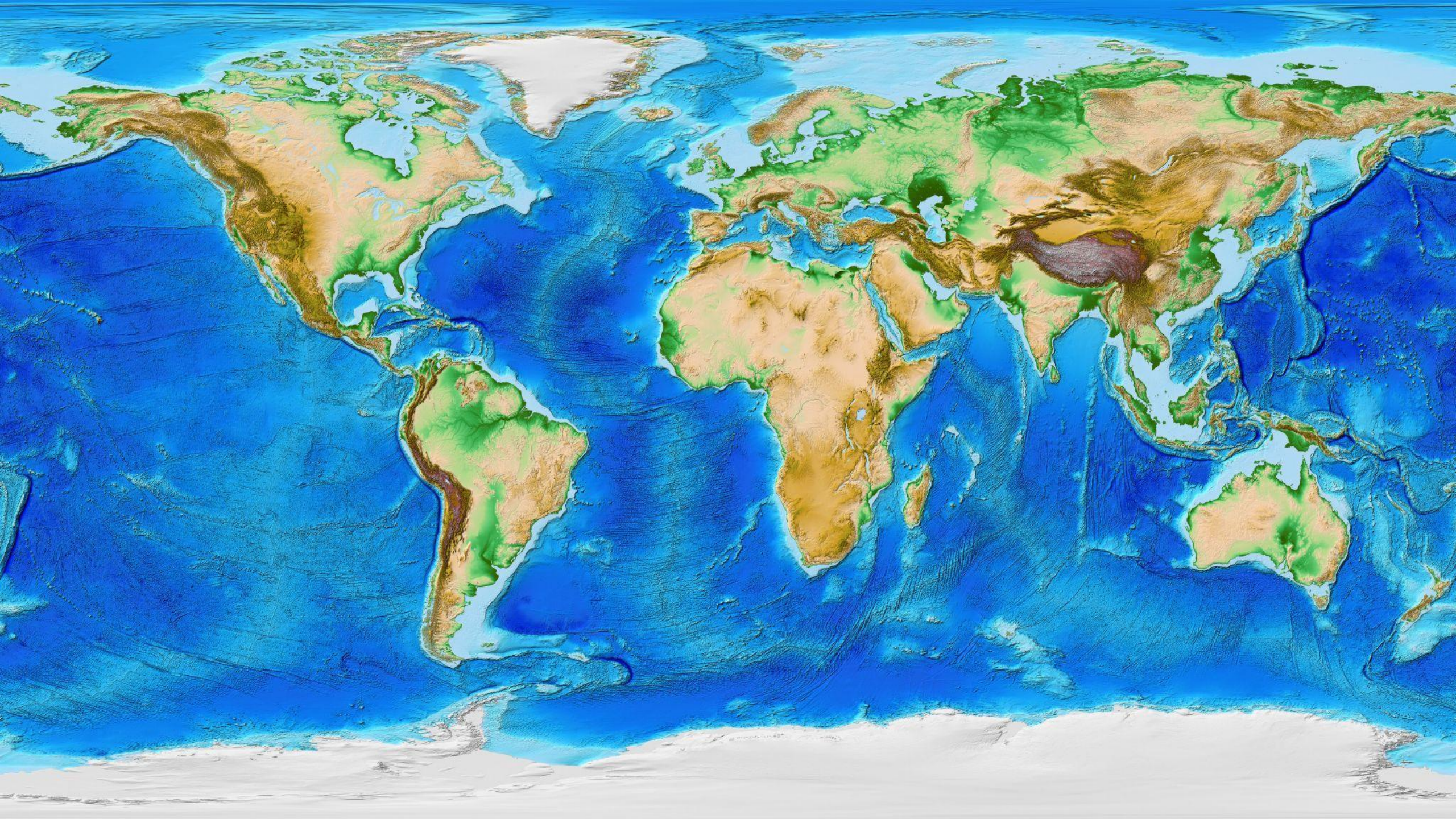


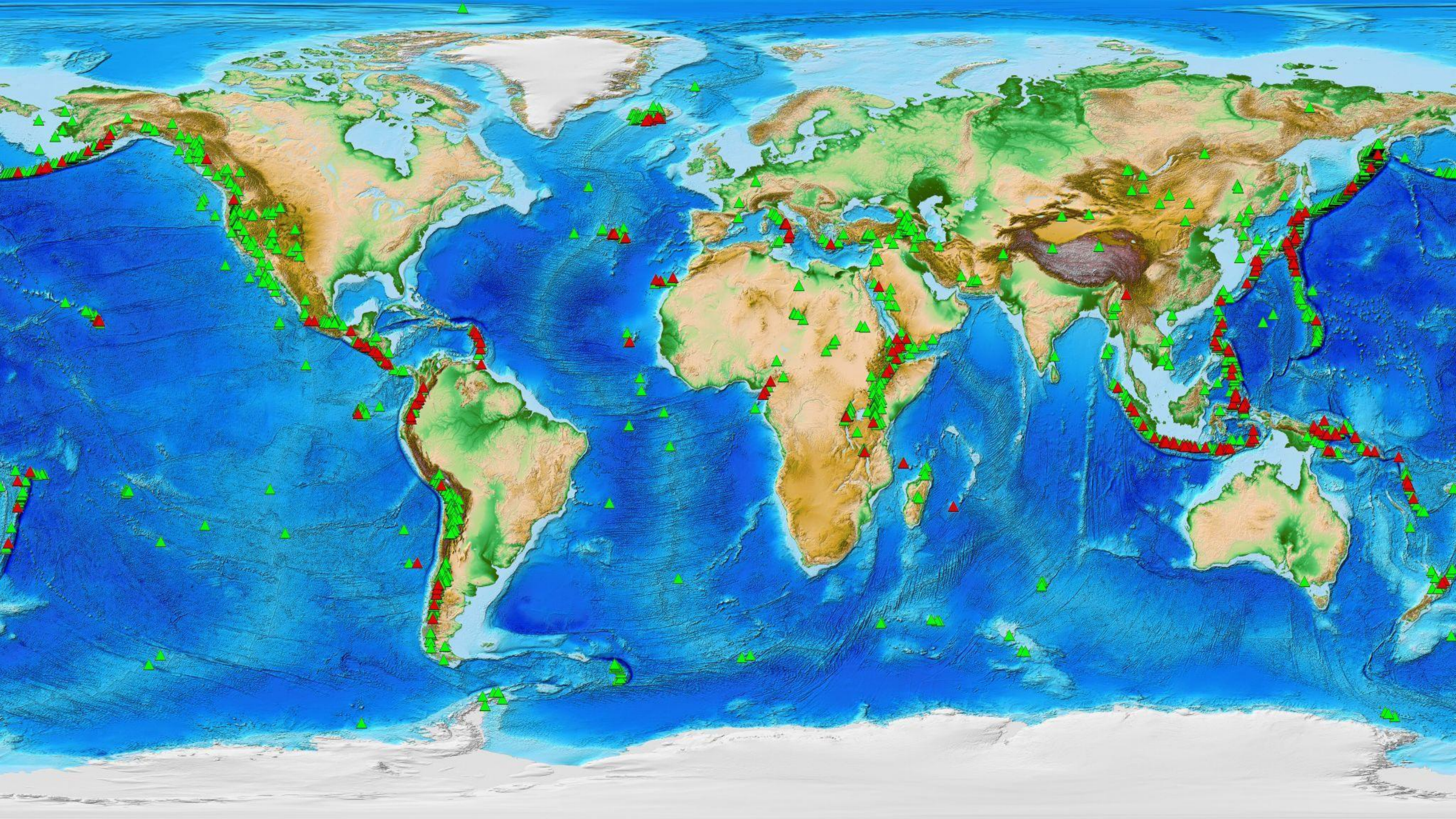

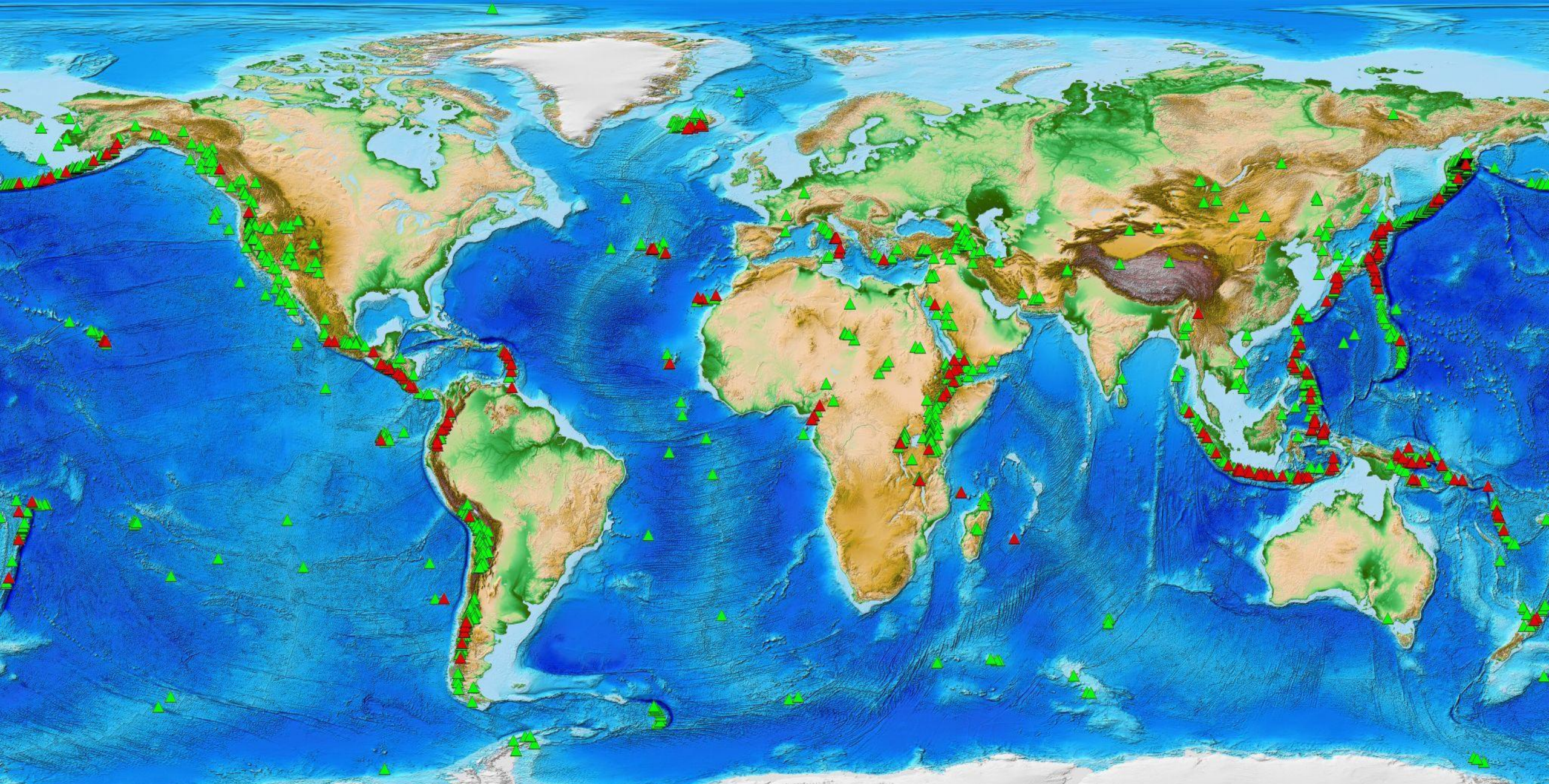
